



## Armeria 'Bee's Lilac'

### EDGING AND CONTAINERS

**Origin:** Victoria, Australia

**Species:** *Armeria alpina*



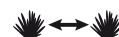
Full sun



Height 15cm



Spread 30m



Edging/borders

### Features:

- A delightful clump forming evergreen plant with gorgeous round blooms
- Stunning lilac coloured flowers in impressive round globes
- Tall stems hold flowers high above foliage
- Flowers last well for cut posies

### Suggested Uses:

- Colourful borders and edging
- Bright addition to rockeries and gravel style gardens
- Containers and baskets
- Cut flower arrangements
- Plant towards the front of garden beds to maximise impact

### Water Requirements:

Low. Dry tolerant once established. An occasional deep watering through periods of extended heat will maintain good performance.

### Care:

A full sun position in well drained soil is recommended. Removing spent flower heads will encourage further displays. Feed with a slow release fertiliser in spring according to manufacturer's directions.
