

Another wonderfully garden-worthy Australian native, Alyogyne 'Ninbella Purple' boasts flower reminiscent of a purple hibiscus and blooms almost continuously from late spring, through summer and well into autumn. It is fast-growing, evergreen and low maintenance. It is beautifully suited to mixed borders, fitting in comfortably with either exotics or other native plants - making it a very striking yet versatile addition to any garden.
