Origin: France

Species: *Hydrangea paniculata*

Protection Status: PBR protected



Full sun



Full sun/part shade

Features:

- Sun hardy and easy to grow
- Strong stems bearing large flowers which open white and then turn pink before becoming deep red
- Long flowering period throughout summer and autumn
- Bushy habit

Suggested Uses:

- Decorative containers
- Rich colour for mixed garden beds
- Brighten courtyards and cottage style gardens
- Feature specimen for small gardens

Water Requirements:

Medium. To enjoy the full development in colours, avoid watering the flowers and leaves directly, water at the base of the plant.

Care:

Feed in early spring for optimum results. Remove spent flower heads after flowering finishes.

Awarded a silver medal at Plantarium in Europe in 2011.
