Features:

- Sun hardy and easy to grow
- Abundant flowers throughout summer and autumn
- Flowers begin green and white and mature through to a range of pinks
- Exceptionally compact and fast growing

Suggested Uses:

- Small spaces
- Patios, balconies and entertainment areas
- Colour for part shade to full sun locations
- Decorative containers

Water Requirements:

Medium. Hydrangeas prefer a moist but well drained soil. Avoid watering the flowers and leaves, water at the base of the plant.

Care:

Feed in early spring for optimum results. Remove spent flower heads after flowering finishes.
