# Agapanthus 'Baby Periwinkle'

## DRY TOLERANT

The little sister to our favourite dwarf Agapanthus - 'Baby Pete'. This variety has all the hardiness and strong features of 'Baby Pete', with a stunning floral display of soft, cool tones.

**Origin:** Brisbane, Australia

**Species:** *Agapanthus praecox* spp. *orientalis*

**Protection Status:** PBR protectable

Height 20cm



Spread 40cm



Edging, Space 30cm apart

## Features:

- Color break on the hugely popular 'Baby Pete'
- Dwarf variety with compact mound forming foliage and flower stems only reaching to approx. 35cm
- Proven to date to be sterile - no environmental weed threat
- Long flowering - throughout warmer months
- Very dry tolerant once established
- Bred in Australia

## Suggested Uses:

- Mass plant as low maintenance ground cover
- Edging paths, drives and other paved surfaces
- Hardy for commercial landscaping or public spaces
- Container displays for hot, sunny locations
- Small gardens, patios and courtyards
- Dry or gravel style gardens
- Great for coastal regions

## Water Requirements:

Low, once established. Quite dry tolerant requiring only occasional deep watering during extended periods of heat.

## Care:

Easy to grow in most soil types which are well draining. Apply a slow release fertiliser in spring. No pruning generally required although removing spent flowering stems will encourage further flushes.
