





Ajuga 'Black Scallop' is the darkest form of any Ajuga available and has a long-standing reputation for its excellent general performance in the home garden. The unique dark foliage colour combines well lime green and gold leaves as well as plants with simple white flowers. The leaves are a scallop-like shape, forming a dense ground cover ideal between pavers, in shallow containers or along the front of a mixed border. Lilac purple flower spikes in the spring and summer which sit proudly above the foliage of the plant.

FEATURES

- Forms a dense mat of foliage in sumptuous shades or purple, brown and black
- Glossy leaves with ruffled margins add textural interest
- Short, deep blue flower spikes from spring to summer
- Excellent showy ground cover for moist, shady areas
- Performs well in the heat, and frost hardy

USES

- Colour and interest in shady areas
- Great colour contrast against lighter coloured plants
- Mass plant under tree canopies
- Edging along shady pathways and around water features

CARE

Medium water requirements. Prefers moist, well draining soil. Best sited in semi-shade for most reliable performance. Shelter from strong afternoon sun. No pruning required. Feed with a single application of slow release fertiliser during spring for optimum results.
