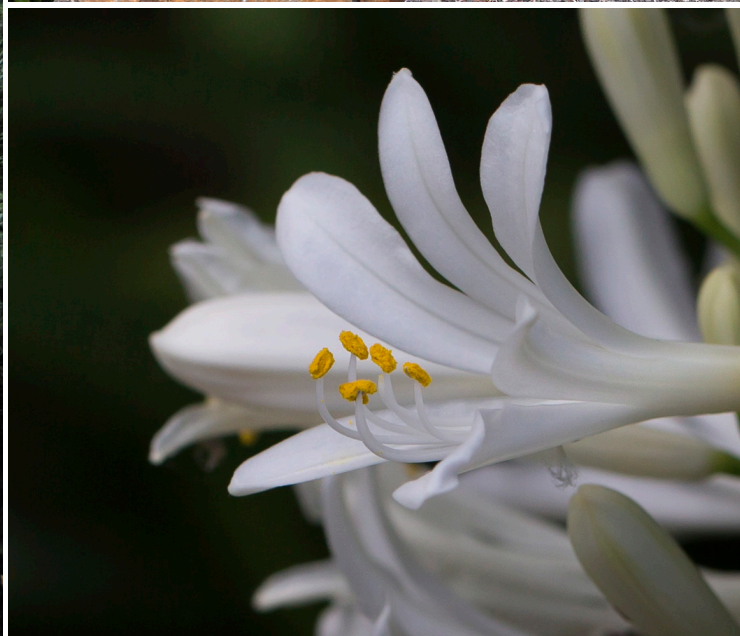


AGAPANTHUS

'PERPETUAL PEACE'

LONG FLOWERING SEASON



Agapanthus 'Perpetual Peace' will win you over with its extremely long flowering season - from October through to May. Bursting with pure white blooms, this variety is a great choice for those seeking a long lasting and carefree display. 'Perpetual Peace' is evergreen, hardy and low maintenance. In addition is dry tolerant once established, making it a preferred selection for water conscious gardens.

FEATURES

- Extremely long flowering – October until May
- Medium sized variety with flowers sitting proudly 60cm above ground, 15cm above foliage
- Evergreen and hardy without any special needs
- Dry tolerant once established
- After extensive trialing, little to no seed set
- Flowers in times when other Agapanthus are not flowering

USES

- Mass plant as low maintenance ground cover
- Edging for paths, driveways and other paved surfaces
- Hardy for commercial landscapes and public open space
- Container displays in hot sunny locations

CARE

Low water requirements. Drought tolerant once established, but will benefit significantly from additional watering throughout the heat of summer. Easy to grow in most soil types which are well draining. Apply a slow release fertiliser in spring. No pruning generally required, although removing spent flower stems will encourage further flushes.
