# 'TE PUNA'

DRY SHADY AREAS



Arthropodium 'Te Puna' is a plant with exceptional garden performance. It thrives in dry shade - a location which is typically difficult to find suitable plants for. 'Te Puna' is a dwarf rock lily native to New Zealand. Here in Australia it performs exceptionally well, rewarding with a mass of white flowers during the spring and summer period. The white flowers provide lovely illumination to dark corners of the garden.

## CARE

Low water requirements. Low. Very dry tolerant once established, requiring only an occasional deep soak during periods of extended heat.

**SPECIES:** *Arthropodium cirratum*
