# 'GREAT BALLS OF FIRE'

HARDY, COMPACT, AND COLOURFUL



'Clippable' plants like Callistemon 'Great Balls of Fire' are useful garden plants that give your garden year-round structure and seasonal interest. Plant this tough and sun-loving native as a low hedge in your garden or as a formal ball in a pot. Easy to maintain with a quick clip in winter, the rich red new growth in spring is a real garden highlight.

- Compact and bushy form of the native bottle-brush
- Hardy for private or public uses including roadside verges, carparks, nature strips, parks and schools as well as other commercial applications

## USES

- Ornamental hedging

## CARE

Medium water requirements. Once established, quite dry tolerant requiring only occasional deep watering during extended periods of heat. Plant in most soil types which are well draining. Feed in spring with a slow release fertiliser for natives. Responds well to regular pruning which encourages fresh growth and dense habit.
