

Euphorbia 'Blackbird' was selected for its outstanding burgundy foliage colour which does not fade throughout the heat of summer or cold of winter. An incredibly hardy plant it's a sure way to add dramatic impact to your garden. 'Blackbird' boasts a very compact, tidy habit with a prolific display of unique flowers of lime yellow from mid-winter continuing into spring. Stunning as a specimen plant 'Blackbird' also looks great when planted alongside Euphorbia 'Silver Swan' and Euphorbia 'Ascot Rainbow'.

CARE

Plant in most soil types that are well draining. Feed in spring with a slow release fertiliser according to manufacturer's directions. Remove spent flower heads to encourage further flushes. If pruning, take care to avoid contact with sap.

Dry tolerant once established, requiring only occasional deep watering during extended periods of heat.
