CARE

Feed in early spring for optimum results. Remove spent flower heads after flowering finishes.

Keep the soil or potting mix moist during hot spells for best results, especially in sunny situations. To enjoy the full development in colours, avoid watering the flowers and leaves directly, water at the base of the plant.
