

Planted in the garden or a pot, Little Bibi is a versatile dwarf Polygala with a naturally mounded habit. Its green foliage is set off by its abundant flowers almost all year round. Long lasting displays of bright purple pea-like flowers make it particularly useful for those looking to impress with a splash of colour. Suitable for full sun and part shade positions, Little Bibi is even frost hardy. This low maintenance evergreen

garden solution responds well to a quick prune making it even suitable for topiary.

CARE

Plant in well drained soil. Prefers a full sun location for optimum results and trim if desired after main flowering period. Feed with a slow release fertiliser and maintain with low levels of water once established.
