



## Rhodanthe 'Paper Baby'

### MASSES OF FLOWERS

**Origin:** Australia

**Species:** *anthemoides*



Full sun



Part Shade



Height 25cm



Spread 40cm

### Features:

- Pink buds opening to white, papery flowers cloak foliage in spring - commonly known as 'everlastings'
- Soft, grey-green foliage forms a neat mound with a trailing habit
- Easy to grow, ornamental native

### Suggested Uses:

- Native or perennial style gardens
- Will cascade over rocks, retaining walls, etc.
- Containers, small gardens and balconies

### Water Requirements:

Occasional deep waterings during extended dry periods is recommended.

### Care:

Plant in a moist but well drained soil. Best suited to a position in morning sun and afternoon shade. Prune back by approximately one third of overall size after flowering. Feed with a slow release fertiliser for optimum results.
