A sister variety to the very popular 'Wendy's Wish', Salvia 'Ember's Wish' has a bright coral flower that is perfect for adding colour and interest into the garden. This fast-growing variety displays vibrant coral coloured flowers for much of the year, particularly during the warmer months. The flowers are tubular and capped by a colourful calyx which remains long after flowering extending its interest even longer. The mid-green foliage appears dense and lush and is further complimented by maroon stems of the plant.

FEATURES

- Large, bright coral flowers right throughout the warmer months
- Tubular flower capped with a colourful pink calyx which remains some time after flowering extending interest even longer
- Mid-green foliage is dense and lush
- Main flush in spring/summer with repeat blooms year round
- Heat and frost hardy
- Fast growing

USES

- Mass plant in drifts for stunning, low maintenance displays
- Large containers
- Mixed borders
- General garden use

CARE

Grows well in most soil types but thrives in fertile, well drained soils. Trim off around one third of size after flowering to maintain shape and encourage a dense, bushy habit. An application of slow release fertiliser in spring will be beneficial. Dry tolerant once established. Requires an occasional long soak during extended periods of heat.
