Species: *violacea*

Full sun/part shade

Dry tolerant

Features:

- Ornamental blue-grey foliage forming an attractive silvery clump
- Dainty lilac- pale pink flowers in spring and summer
- Extremely hardy, dry tolerant and great for boggy and coastal areas

Suggested Uses:

- Informal edging along garden borders and pathways
- Mass plant on difficult sites for erosion control
- Rockeries and retaining walls
- Cottage style gardens
- General use for low maintenance areas

Water Requirements:

Low once established. Simply provide an occasional deep water during periods of extended heat.

Care:

Grows well in most soil types but thrives in those rich in compost. Pruning generally not required.

Apply a slow release fertiliser in early spring for best results.
