## FEATURES

- Flowering begins in spring with repeat flushes throughout summer
- Compact habit - ideal for highlighting fences, walls and arbors without engulfing the structure

## USES

- Train to climb fences, trellises and walls
- Trail over embankments and slopes
- Cover unsightly structures
- Large decorative containers

## CARE

Medium water requirements. Dry tolerant once established, needing only an occasional long soak during extended periods of heat. A light trim following flowering and an annual feed of a slowrelease fertiliser in early spring will ensure neat healthy growth.
